Statement Relating to Eligibility



A conviction for a crime involving moral turpitude (misdemeanor or felony) OR a felony, at any time, <u>disqualifies</u> you from an appointment as notary public under Texas law. <u>All applicants are subject to a background check by the Sec of State's Office</u>.

Select ONE of the following options:

A. I, the above-named applicant, have never been convicted of a crime OR I have only been convicted of a Class C misdemeanor.

OR

B. I, the above-named applicant, have been found guilty of a crime other than a Class C misdemeanor.

Applicants selecting this option must submit the following items for each conviction:

- 1. Copy of the Court Order, Sentencing, and all documents pertaining to release from probation (if applicable).
- 2. A statement of the nature, circumstances, date, and location relating to the convictions(s) of the crimes(s) and whether the case is on appeal.
